
Obstetrics and Gynecology eConsults

The eConsultBASE™ service improves access to specialist care for patients by facilitating electronic communication between Primary Care Providers (PCPs) and specialists

From July 2011 to January 2015, **151 PCPs** directed **394 eConsults** to obstetrics and gynecology

Content of questions asked by PCPs % of eConsults



Other* 29%

Pregnancy issues 18%

Gynecologic cancer screening 18%

Vulvovaginal symptom 13%

Abnormal uterine bleeding 12%

Contraception 10%

*Topics included: menopause, abnormal pelvic ultrasonography, and fibromyoma uterus



Referral was originally considered but **avoided** as a result of eConsult



99% of cases were completed within **15 minutes**

The most common questions from PCPs pertained to...



39% Management

- General management
- Necessity of a referral



28% Drug Treatment

- Choice of drug
- Safety of drug in pregnancy
- How specific drugs are prescribed



19% Diagnosis

eConsults provided PCPs with advice for a new or additional course of action





Existing plan of treatment was confirmed

Case Example



PCP has a patient in her early 30s with a bicornuate uterus who is interested in getting an IUD. PCP asks specialist if patient would be a good candidate.



Specialist responds with recommendation that an IUD would not be appropriate for the patient.



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PCP accepts advice and closes case.
